In Fiscal Year 2007, The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing, within the corporation of the Village of Georgetown, on SR125, heading east, beginning at SLM 9.13, and leaving the Village at the east corporation limit at SLM 10.42, to overlay the existing pavement with asphalt concrete.

Except for all costs of added construction items generating extra work contracts under Ohio Laws, unless performance is approved by the State of Ohio and the Federal Highway Administration before work is authorized.

SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U. S. C., Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.



In Fiscal Year 2007, The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing, within the corporation of the Village of Georgetown, on SR125, heading east, beginning at SLM 9.13, and leaving the Village at the east corporation limit at SLM 10.42, to overlay the existing pavement with asphalt concrete.

Since the above mentioned portion is within the corporation limits of the Village of Georgetown, it will be necessary that we obtain Consent Legislation from the Village. We are enclosing three (3) copies of said Legislation which shall require action by the Village Council.

In completing this form, please be sure to do the following:

1. Indicate the Ordinance/Resolution number in the upper right hand corner of the first page.
2. Please note that on the second page, in Section VI, the person who is designated as your "Contractual Agent" (usually this is the Mayor or Village Administrator) is to sign in the space marked "Contractual Agent", and
3. on the Certificate of Copy, this same person is to sign in the space marked "Contractual Officer".
4. Also in Section VI, the Mayor is to sign in the space "Officer of LPA".


5. Again, in Section VI, the President of the Village Council is to sign in the space marked "President of Council". If the Village has no President of Council, then the Mayor or Village Administrator may also sign in that space.
6. All three (3) spaces marked "Attested" (two in Section VI and one on the Certificate) need to be signed by either a Councilman or the Village Clerk.
7. After all the appropriate spaces have been filled in and all signatures have been affixed and dated, then make a copy for your records and return all three original copies to: **ODOT, Dist. 9, Attention Toby Smalley, Liaison Officer, P. O. Box 467, 650 Eastern Avenue, Chillicothe, Ohio 45660.**
8. After the Deputy Director signs the "Certificate of Copy", we will send one original back to you.
