VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1051

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A NEW AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AS COURT COSTS FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN MAYOR'S COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the court costs for the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court are presently set at \$50.00 of which a portion is paid to the State of Ohio and a portion of which is paid into the Mayor's Court computer fund; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the court costs for the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court in order for the Mayor's Court to operate on a sound fiscal basis;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The court costs for the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court shall be and hereby are increased to \$70.00 total effective for all new cases filed in the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court after the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Any portion of the court costs required to be remitted to the State of Ohio or required to be paid into the Mayor's Court computer fund shall continue to be so remitted and paid with the balance thereof to be allocated to the operation of the Court.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Georgetown and more particularly for the reason that it is necessary to increase the court costs for the Mayor's Court of the Village of Georgetown in order that said Court can continue to operate on a sound fiscal basis and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
