ORDINANCE NO. 1070

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A NEW AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AS COURT COSTS FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN MAYOR'S COURT

WHEREAS, the court costs for the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court are presently set at \$70.00 of which \$34.00 is paid to the State of Ohio and \$5.00 is paid into the Mayor's Court computer fund, leaving only \$31.00 being available for the operation of the Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase the court costs for the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court in order for the Mayor's Court to operate on a sound fiscal basis;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds or more of all members thereof concurring, that;

SECTION 1. The court costs for the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court shall be and hereby are increased to \$80.00 total effective for all new cases filed in the Village of Georgetown Mayor's Court after the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Any portion of the court costs required to be remitted to the State of Ohio or required to be paid into the Mayor's Court computer fund shall continue to be so remitted and paid with the balance thereof to be allocated to the operation of the Court.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
