Resolution No. 1128

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NATUREWORKS GRANT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATED TO IT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks Program, and

Whereas, the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Program.

Now Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, with at least two-thirds affirmative vote;

Section 1: That the Village of Georgetown approves filing of an application for financial assistance under the NatureWorks Program.

Section 2: That Dale E. Cahall, as Mayor of the Village of Georgetown, is authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources any related documents and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3: That the Village of Georgetown does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Program.

Section 4: This resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare of the Village of Georgetown, to ensure the timely submission of the grant application and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage.
