

ORDINANCE NO. 267

AN ORDINANCE FIXING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE USE OF PARKING METERS INSTALLED IN THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO, AND REPEALING PARTS OF ORDINANCE NO. 232 OF SAID VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. Each Police Officer shall attach to every vehicle parking in violation of any of the provisions of an Ordinance or Ordinances regulating the use of Parking Meters of the Village of Georgetown, Ohio, a notice that such vehicle has been illegally parked and by such notice instruct the operator of said vehicle to report at the Police Department of said city in regard to such violation. Each such person receiving said notice may, within one hour of the time when such notice was attached to such vehicle as the penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation the sum of Twenty Five Cents (25¢) for the first hour; and for the second hour the sum of Fifty Cents (50¢); and for the third and successive hour of the continuance of said violation said operator shall be assessed the sum of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) for each and every offense after the violation of more than two hours.

Section 2. Be It Further Ordained that Section 12 of Ordinance No. 232 be, and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
