

ORDINANCE NO. 279

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF MONEY FOR
ADDITIONAL EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS OF
THE VILLAGE OF GEROGETOWN, OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Georgetown,
Brown County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That there exists the necessity for the hiring of
additional personnel in the office of the Board of Public Affairs of
the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, and that the cost of
said additional employe or employees will not exceed One Thousand
Eight Hundred (\$1,800.00) Dollars for the year 1957, and that the
duty of said employee shall be clerical work in the office of the
Board of Public Affairs of the Village of Georgetown, Ohio, and which
sum shall be and hereby is appropriated out of the funds of the Board
of Public Affairs for such purpose.


Section 2. That this Ordinance is passed to comply with a
certification made to Council by the Board of Public Affairs and is of
an emergency nature for the preservation of the health, safety and
welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Georgetown, and shall be
effective immediately upon its passage.

Section 3. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in-
consistent herewith be and the same hereby are repealed.
