RESOLUTION NO. 1207

**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING TYLER THOMPSON AS THE
VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, OHIO'S DESIGNEE IN COMPLIANCE
WITH EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS OF HOUSE BILL 9**

WHEREAS, the 126th Ohio General Assembly approved House Bill 9 to ensure that employees of public office are appropriately educated regarding obligations under Ohio's Open Records law; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 9 requires all elected officials or their appropriate designees to obtain three hours of training approved by the Ohio Attorney General during each term served in elected office; and

WHEREAS, the successful completion by an elected official or elected official's designee of the training session established by the Attorney General will satisfy the education requirements that House Bill 9 imposes; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 9 requires the State Auditor, in the course of an annual or biennial audit of a public office, to monitor the public office for compliance of the State requirements and provisions regarding training and public records policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio:


Section 1: Tyler Thompson is hereby designated as Village Council's designee and designee for each Village Council Member individually in compliance with the education requirements of House Bill 9.

Section 2: Tyler Thompson is hereby required to obtain and document three (3) hours of training approved by the Ohio Attorney General for Village Council Members: Kelly Cornette, Wade Highlander, Dave Guenther, Forrest "Buddy" Coburn, Virginia "Ginny" Colwell and Andy Clift and Dale Cahall as Mayor; and

Section 3: Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this legislation were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committee, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect from and after the earlier time allowed by law.
