### **Completed Action Items**

- Kelly Heslar's monument sign proposal was discussed with the CDC and Council. The design is attached. Please let me know if you have any other suggestions for it.
- I sent an invitation to Tyler Rumpke and Bob Kras to attend the October 22 Council Meeting. They said they'll be here.

### **In-progress Action Items**

- The firehouse project bid is out to contractors now and will be advertised in the newspaper for a couple of weeks. The bid opening is October 22.

### **Miscellaneous Items**

- The Village Offices are closed on Monday, October 12 for Columbus Day.
- The SR 125 sewer break was repaired on Monday. Thanks to Unger Construction for mobilizing so quickly. I have not yet received any word from the EPA on any potential fines for the SSO.
- Chris Fogle from Grow, Inc donated some very nice photographs (Light Art) of the Brown County Covered Bridges as a thank you to our staff for spending some time helping one of their participants with their career development. We'll find a nice spot for them in the building.
- I'll have a supplemental appropriation for roughly \$30K prepared for the next council meeting to begin a water system infrastructure needs assessment. This is absolutely critical for us to plan a sustainable future for the water utility.
- We should have a supplemental appropriation and award on October 22 for an electrical system evaluation as well. I'm not sure what the cost will be yet. Again, as we consider putting additional services on our electric grid it is vital that we know all the costs beyond the initial acquisition. Running new lines, upgrading substations, and even potentially needing to replace the newly purchased assets are all costs that must be considered.
- I'm scoping a facilities needs assessment project with Larry Hatfield as well. As we've discussed, our Water/Street/Sewer building is in very poor shape. The front Electric Building isn't in great condition either.

- The Brown County flag was delivered yesterday, so probably next week or the following we'll get them installed on the front of the building. I think it will really spruce up the place. A picture of the county flag is attached, if you aren't familiar with it.
