In-progress Action Items

- North Shore Design is preparing the additional design work associated with mechanical and electrical improvements to the firehouse. Based on Council's direction we've directed them to complete the drawings for improvements throughout the living space (floor, paint, HVAC to the Chief's office, etc.).

Pending Action Items

- There are reports of rats in the storm sewer near the Main St. Frontier building which we will investigate.
- We'll be starting design work on ADA improvements for the front of the Gaslight Theater soon, which will include the flags as requested by Council.

Miscellaneous Items

- The presentations from the Ohio EPA and Rumpke are attached for your review.
- Members of the Charter Commission have been hard at work folding, labeling, and stuffing envelopes for mailing the proposed charter to all registered voters in the Village. They still have quite a few to go, but hopefully it will be wrapped up in the next week or so.
- It's taken quite a while, but we hope to be able to soon acquire and demolish 718 East State Street. If it works out the way Joe's planning this should serve as a model process for how to deal with vacant and abandoned properties going forward. My hope is to have legislation for Council on this in the next month or two.
