ORDINANCE NO. 1288

**ORDINANCE ACCEPTING CAHALL BROS. LANE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Cahall Bros. Lane, Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio (“Road”) was dedicated to the public pursuant to that certain Dedication Plat recorded in Plat Cabinet 2, Page 559, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, the Road has been completed and maintained by the Village of Georgetown and used by the public for a number of years, but has not been formally accepted for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Georgetown now wishes to place of record an acceptance of such Road.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, at least two-thirds of all members thereof concurring as follows:

Section 1. Council effective immediately hereby accepts the Road and directs the Mayor and/or the Clerk to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with attachments with the Brown County Recorder’s Office.

Section 2. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is that this will allow for the sale of property adjacent to the Road. Therefore, provided this emergency Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members


elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
