ORDINANCE NO. 1295

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission for Brown County, Ohio has issued an Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2021 for the Village of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received funding through the approval of an OWDA loan for the Home Street - Banting Road Water Tower Rehab Project and where the Village plans to start the 2021 Hamer Road Paving Project, that it is necessary in order to provide for the expenditures that a supplemental appropriation be made based on said Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources to appropriate funds not heretofore appropriated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, By the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:


SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources received from the Budget Commission of Brown County previously unappropriated as follows:
