ORDINANCE NO. 1296

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission for Brown County, Ohio has issued an Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2021 for the Village of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, the Village Electric Department has contracted with Hi-Tech Electrical Contractors LLC for the Free Soil Rd. 3-phase line reconductoring and for the replacement of 30 poles; and to pay for the expense that a supplemental appropriation be made based on said Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources to appropriate funds not heretofore appropriated.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:


SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources received from the Budget Commission of Brown County previously unappropriated as follows:
