RESOLUTION NO. 1294

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BROWN COUNTY LAND BANK FOR THE DEMOLITION OF THE STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 112 EAST STATE STREET

WHEREAS, the Village of Georgetown is the owner of certain real property known as Brown County Parcel No. 33-068580.000 located at 112 East State Street which includes a structure formerly used for the operation of a commercial business; and

WHEREAS, the Village has no municipal purpose for the structure and seeks to demolish it through the Brown County Land Bank.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:


SECTION 1: Council of the Village of Georgetown (“Village Council”) declares that the structure located on Brown County Parcel No. 33-068580.000 at 112 East State Street has no municipal purpose and seeks to have the structure demolished.

SECTION 2. That the Village Administrator is authorized to enter into an agreement on behalf of the Village of Georgetown with the Brown County Land Bank for the demolition of the structure located at 112 East State Street. A copy of the Agreement is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3: That the Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
