

**Special Session of Council
Village of Georgetown
February 3, 2022**

The Georgetown Village Council convened in special session on Thursday, February 3, 2022, from 10:04 AM until 10:11 AM in the Municipal Building, Council Chambers. Councilmember Cornette called the meeting to order with the pledge of allegiance.

Mayor Cahall is out of town so as President of Council, Councilmember Cornette led the Special Session of Council.

Councilmember Cornette asked for an attendance roll call with the following Councilmembers present: Mark Anderson, Kelly Cornette, Mike Mays, Nancy Montgomery, Jeremy Varner and Steve Wolfe. Employees present: Fiscal Officer Natalie Newberry and Administrator Owens.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

No public comments were made.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS AFFECTING THE SAFETY OF RESIDENTS AND THE PROVISION OF MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS AND SERVICES was brought to the table and read by title only. Administrator Owens explained that this resolution allows for emergency decisions to be made during the upcoming winter weather emergency to keep the Village functioning. It would allow him to make fixes that would typically be above his spending limit. It also allows the Village to apply for any funding made available by the Federal Government in conjunction with the storm. This can be rescinded by Council at any time. Councilmember Varner made a motion to adopt with a second from Councilmember Mays. Councilmember Cornette called for a roll call vote with Councilmembers Anderson, Cornette, Mays, Montgomery, Varner, and Wolfe voting yea. Motion carried.

Administrator Owens asks community members to contact the Village with any problems direct and provided several contacts so as not to overload 911.

ADJOURNMENT:

Councilmember Wolfe made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Councilmember Mays. Meeting adjourned by voice vote.
