ORDINANCE NO. 1332

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
FOR THE VILLAGE OF GEORGETOWN, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission for Brown County, Ohio has issued an Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023 for the Village of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, the Village requests that a supplemental appropriation be made based on said Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources to appropriate funds not heretofore appropriated for the purpose of donating \$10,000 to the Brown County Humane Society for the TNR Program within the Village of Georgetown limits; and to appropriate a donation of \$5,000 for the US Grant Homestead Association 2023 firework display in continuation with the celebration of the 200th Birthday of Ulysses S. Grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, By the Council of the Village of Georgetown, Brown County, Ohio, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources received from the Budget Commission of Brown County previously unappropriated as follows:

SECTION 2. That the Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
